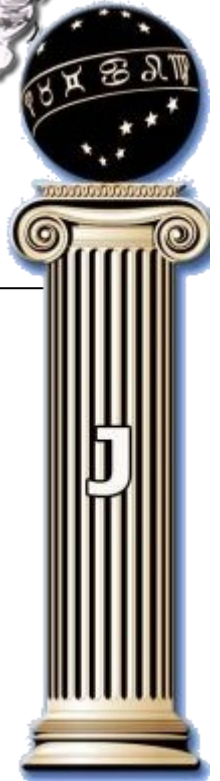
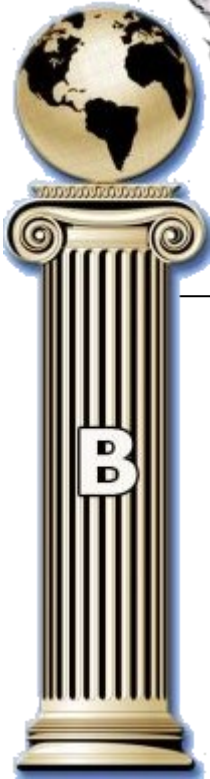

Brethren,

First and foremost - please come out to our Stated Meeting on Monday, March 08th. We will be discussing a possible By-Laws change regarding the day of the week our Stated Meetings are held. We have a Resolution that has been drawn up and proposed to change our Stated Meetings to the first Tuesday of each month. This has been suggested since our current Stated Meeting night is on the 2nd Monday which falls on the same night as Tampa Scottish Rite. So far, the speakers have been really well versed, have imparted knowledge to our Brothers and each presentation has been very enjoyable.

I've noticed a considerable decrease in participation - we are about a quarter of the way to our goal of 100 gallons of tabs.
